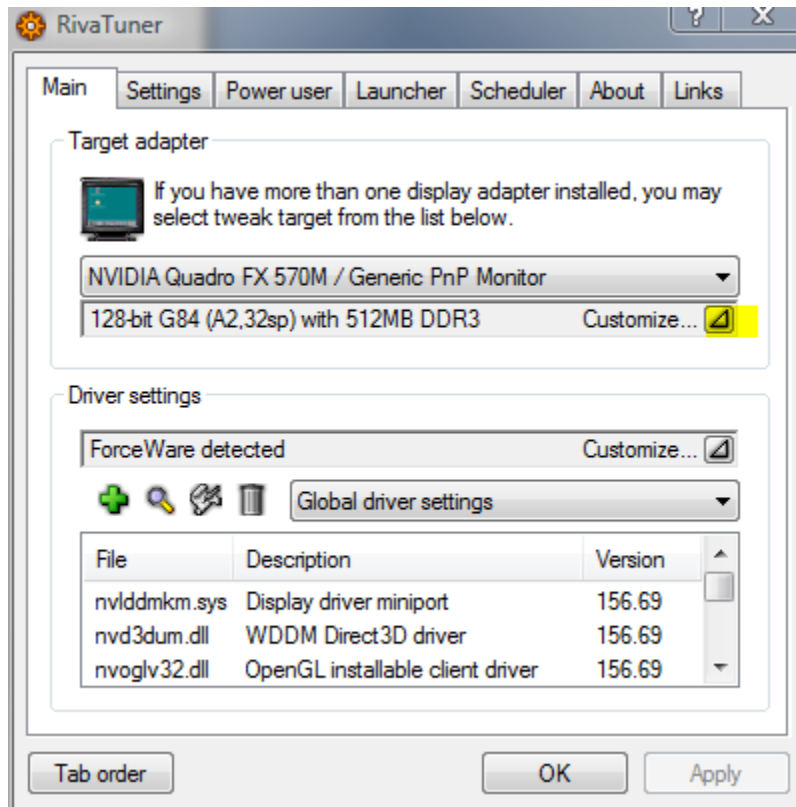


How to Soft-MOD your MacBook Pro with nVidia GeForce 8600M GT for VISTA

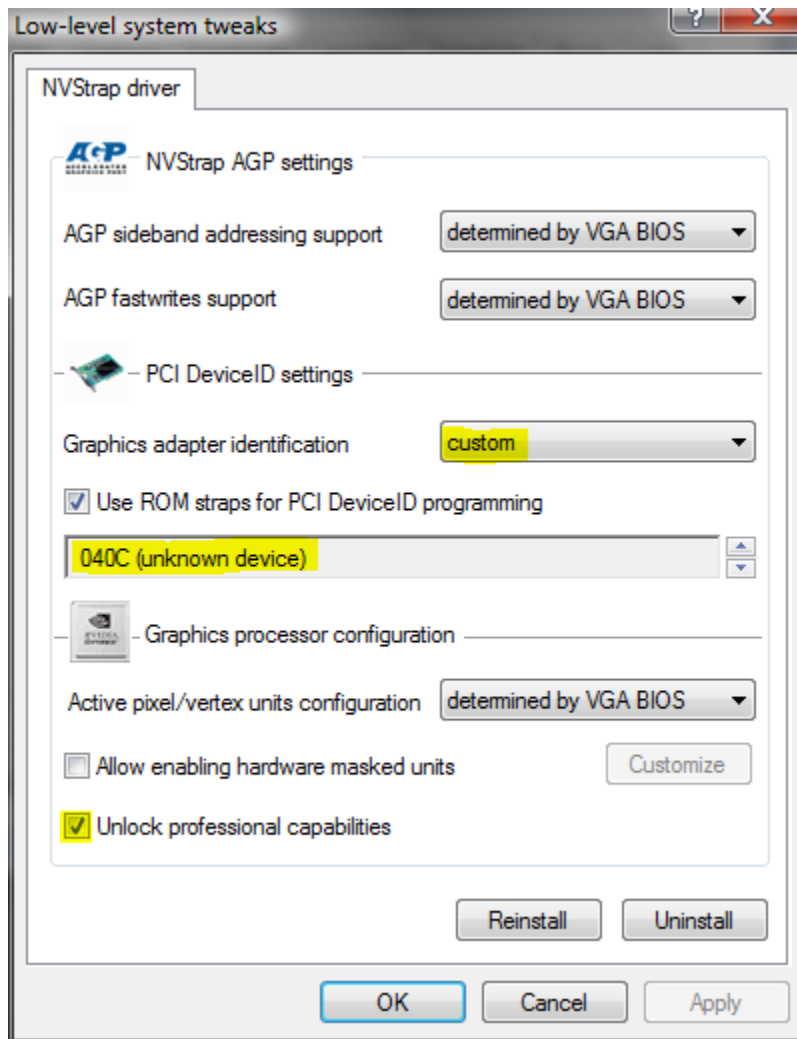
Step 1: Download RivaTuner from: <http://downloads.guru3d.com/download.php?det=163>

Step 2: Install RivaTuner and run.

Step 3: Click on Customize (Note: your adapter will say NVIDIA GeForce 8600M GT) select “Low-level system settings”



Step 4: Under “Graphics adapter identification” select “custom” then select “040C (unknown device)” and check “Unlock professional capabilities” and click OK. This will require a reboot to apply. (Note: after the reboot, RivaTuner’s tweaks will set your Display Adapter to “Generic Display Adapter”)

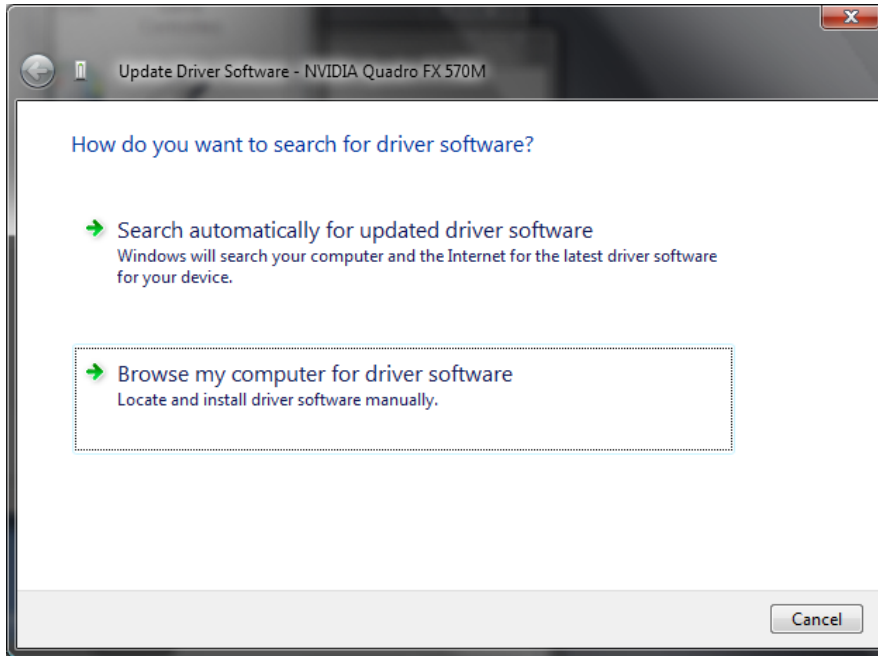


Step 5: Download the nVidia Quadro 570M driver from <http://www-307.ibm.com/pc/support/site.wss/license.do?filename=mobiles/7kd543ww.exe>

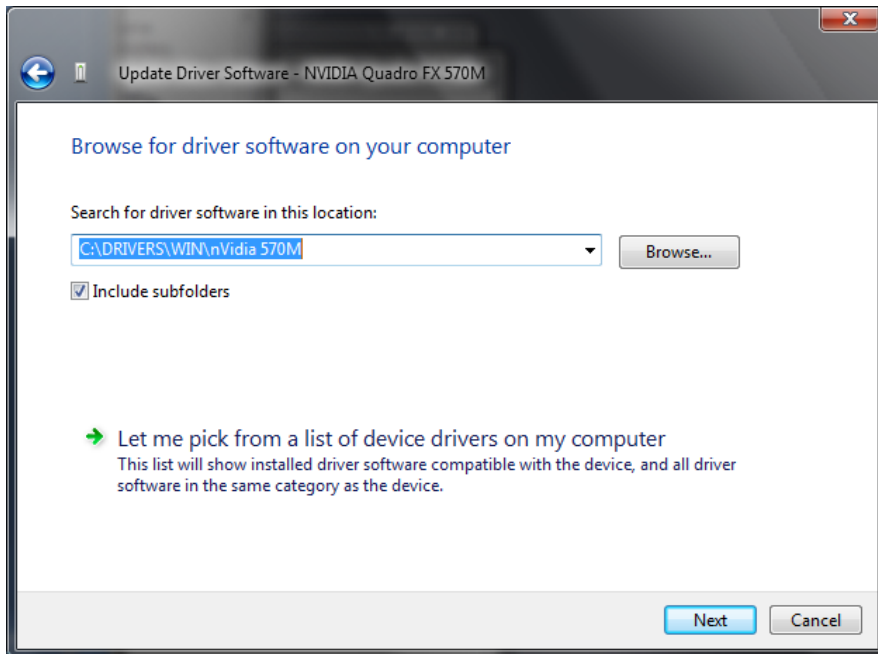
Step 6: Unzip the driver (don't install).

Step 7: From the Control Panel, Device Manager, Expand Display Adapters and right click on “Generic Display Adapter” and select “Update Driver”.

Step 8: Select “Browse my computer for driver software”



Step 9: Select “Let me pick from a list of device drivers on my computer”



Step 10: Now click “Have Disk” and browse to your unzip location of the Quadro 570M driver.

Step 11: Now follow the rest of the directions through applying the new driver and now when you launch SolidWorks, RealView should be available in your menu.

Step 12: Hold on to your shorts because it is the fastest ride out there!
